


### **Challenges**





Each Pourashava and City Corporation has its own Local Development Plan, but these plans are not properly linked with the national plans and sectoral plans by the sector ministries.












### Local government structure of Bangladesh



Upazila (491+)

Union (4553+)

"Upazilla Parishad Act (amended) 2011, A committee for budget, finance, planning and local resource mobilization.

A financial estimate for the implementation of those local plan has to be prepared (with proposal of needed resource mobilization)

"Union Parishad (Dev. Planning) Rues 2013"

UP will formulate and implement 5yr and annual plan wherein which goals and objectives of national plans are to be reflected;









### Local government structure of Bangladesh

#### Pourashava Act 2010

- Each Pourashava shall prepare a Master Plan within 5 years of its establishment which among others will include local development programme/plan
- Pourashavas will prepare and implement development plan for a specified period- UDD and LGED supporting to prepare their plans
- Each Pourashava prepares and sanctions each FY's budget.

#### **City Corporation Act 2009**

- City Corporations will formulate and implement a development plan for a specific period (Art. 28). They will mobilize resources for the implementation of the plan.
- They can invest a part or full of their revenue for the implementation of their development plan.
- Master plan is available in each city corporation. Development authorities are supporting to prepare their plans.

### Is Bangladesh Ready for Integration?

### Focus of 7th Five-Year Plan on Integration of national and local development plan

- Developing planning and budgeting capacities at the local level to help design and implement local level programmes.
- The LGIs will have their annual and five year plan aligned with the national planning goals and strategies for spending resources (as of Local Govt. Act & Rules)
- Planning Commission will issue guidelines for local level plan, extend necessary support to prepare the plan.
- All national level socio- economic development projects implemented locally will be integrated with the local plan.
- Participation of LGIs in local components of the national projects will be ensured during the formulation of the projects at national level.









### Is Bangladesh Ready for Integration?

### Reality

- There is a policy gap of up taking local development plans in national plan making.
- Inadequate linkages to the Central level Planning or Budgeting system
- Resources constraints to implement the Local Level Plan
- Lack of understanding and capacity at both National and Local level
- Financial authority of LGIs is very low
- Highly Politicized regarding development initiatives.
- Spatial planning is completely missing
- Piecemeal efforts without any integration
- Share of local government institutions to National development budget is inadequate.
